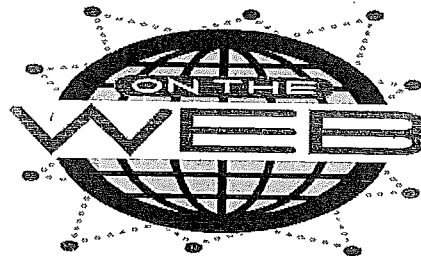

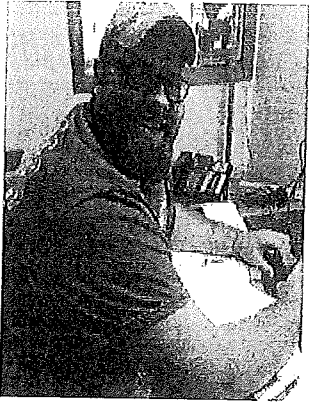

Well, all of those questions have been put to rest, they know where my boundaries are and that they do not move.

Consistency is "conformity in the application of something, typically that which is necessary for the sake of logic, accuracy, or fairness".

Consistency is one of the most important elements that we offer the students who come to the Warehouse. We work hard to locate and implant caring consistent adults into our program who will meet your students in relationship and spur them on towards realistic goals and benchmarks. The staff and volunteers that God provided for us this year have done that is such a full way, which has been a huge blessing.

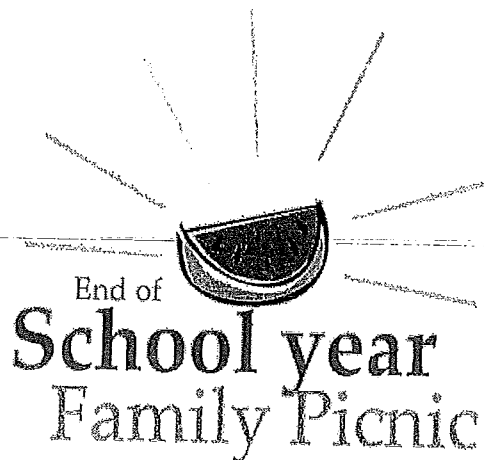

Swimmers should be able to:

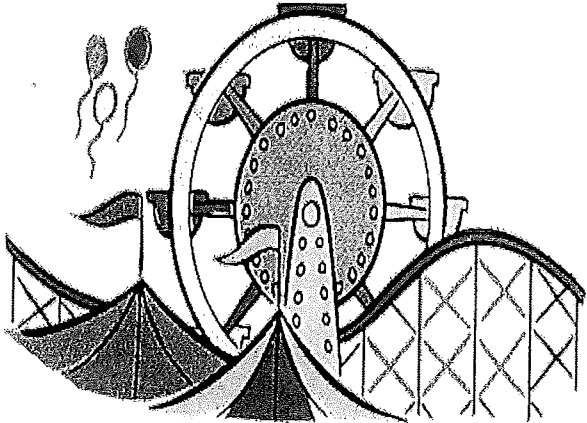
- Efficiently perform front and back crawl (10 yards)
- Tread water for at least one minute

- Survival skills (treading water, jellyfish float)
- Distance swimming (front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke)
- Breast stroke
- Alternate breathing.

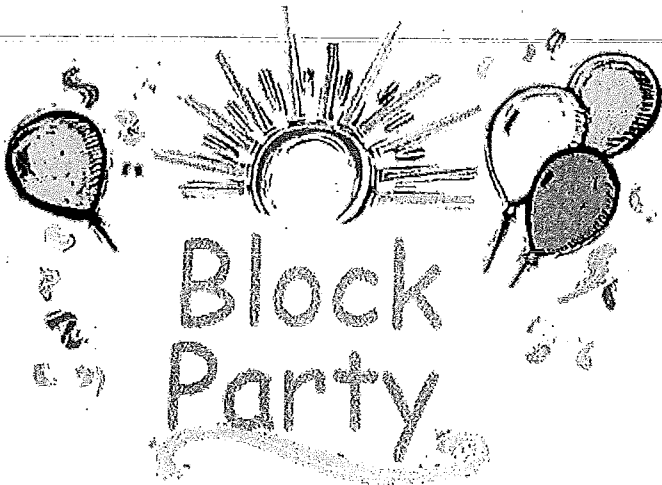

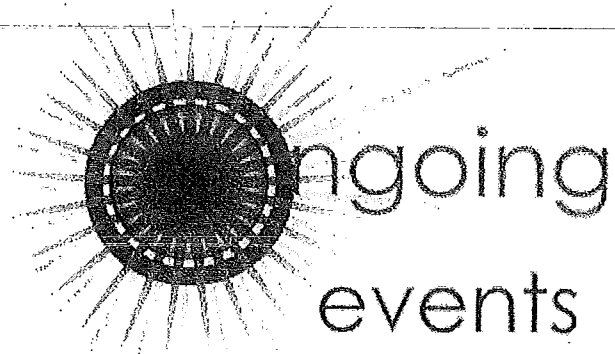

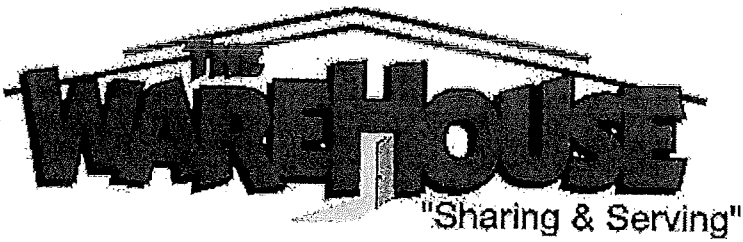
